## **POSITION SUMMARY** Receive patient phone calls and consult on patient inquiries. Provide medical support for patients with questions, determine course of action, and document within the medical record. Work is conducted remotely, outside of a traditional office environment. Must be able to perform work at a dedicated work space with limited interruption or distraction, and high speed internet capability. **ESSENTIAL FUNCTIONS** Answer incoming phone calls regarding patient medical concerns. • Coordinate care per provider protocol and interaction with patient on phone. • Answer patient questions and directing calls and messages to the appropriate personnel. Obtain additional information for providers as needed to respond to patient concerns. Maintain patient confidence and keep information confidential. Assist schedulers with questions regarding patient conditions. Document all patient interactions within the electronic health record. Report to the office location, as needed Perform other responsibilities associated with this position as deemed appropriate GENERAL COMPENTENCIES DESIRED Self-motivated, with the ability to work independently, with minimal supervision. ٠ Excellent organizational, communication skills, telephone, and exceptional customer service skills. Ability to interact effectively with patients and co-workers and possess excellent listening and interpretive skills.
